The UnAmerican Struggle Wins “Best Political Documentary” Award

Atlanta, GA (September 16, 2017) - 1366 Films, an Atlanta-based production company, is excited to announce *The UnAmerican Struggle* has won the ***Best Political Documentary*** award in the 12th annual Atlanta International Documentary Film Festival (Atlanta DocuFest).

The award was given for *The UnAmerican Struggle's* unique and complex examination of the resurgence of racism, misogyny, sexism, and xenophobia in America. The film was chosen as an “Official Selection” for the Atlanta DocuFest and premiered on Friday, September 8, 2017 at 6:15 p.m. at the Synchronicity Theatre in Atlanta Georgia.
