Award-winning film exposing bigotry in Trump America set for Atlanta Premiere

Atlanta, GA (August 23, 2017) – *The UnAmerican Struggle* has been chosen as an “Official Selection” for the 12th annual Atlanta International Documentary Film Festival (Atlanta DocuFest). The film’s Atlanta premiere will take place on Friday, September 8, 2017 at 6:15 p.m. at the Synchronicity Theatre in Atlanta Georgia.

The UnAmerican Struggle is a feature-length documentary that examines the resurgence of racism, misogyny, sexism, and xenophobia in America brought about by Donald Trump's words and actions as a candidate, and now his policies as president.

The film provides a voice to groups affected by the intolerance and bigotry sweeping the nation like a cancer, as evident from the violence perpetrated by white supremacists in Charlottesville, Virginia in August. The film also speaks to the dangers of remaining silent in the face of state-inspired hate and threats to civil rights.

The UnAmerican Struggle, winner of the *Award of Merit Special Mention* in the IndieFEST Film Awards, pays close attention to the struggle for equality from the perspective of Immigrants, Latinos, Muslims, Blacks, Women, and Transgender people. Seventeen experts representing the Southern Poverty Law Center, the National Diversity Council, the Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR) and local groups, such as Black Lives Matter, lent their voices to the film to educate viewers about the reality of bigotry in America and the need to return the country to its principles rooted in tolerance and diversity.
